WHAT IS THE RECITAL?



Our annual recital is a joy-filled day of performances and the culmination of a year's worth of hard work! While our recital is not mandatory, we highly suggest that students participate and each year 99% of our students from age 2-18 do perform at the recitals.*

Beginning in January, each teacher creates customized age-appropriate choreography for their classes. After months of practice during class time, the year culminates as each class showcases their dance wearing a special age-appropriate costume, tights and dance shoes on stage at Regis College.

WHAT IS THE COSTUME FEE?



Costume Fees are processed on November 15th through your on file payment method in the parent portal:
\$70.00/costume for Grow With Us classes
\$75.00/costume for all other classes

Dancers are measured in class the week of Nov. 7th. Costumes are non-refundable and non-returnable. Every dancer participating in the recital must pay for and wear the costume to perform. Costumes are distributed in class in late April.
